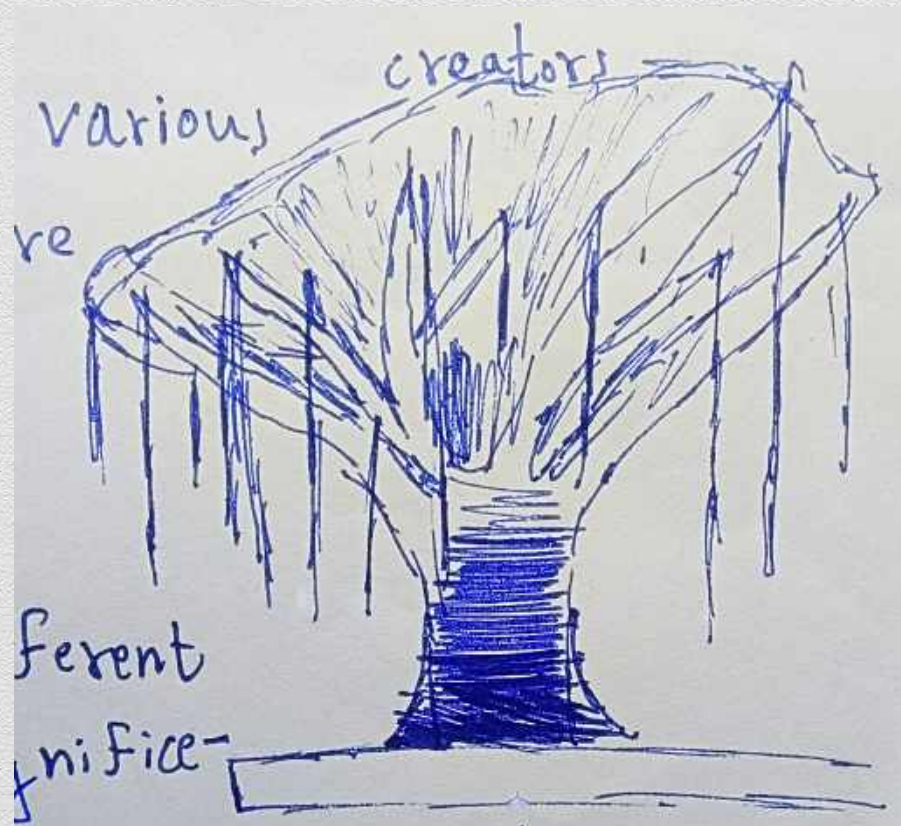
HARAT IS THE PLACE

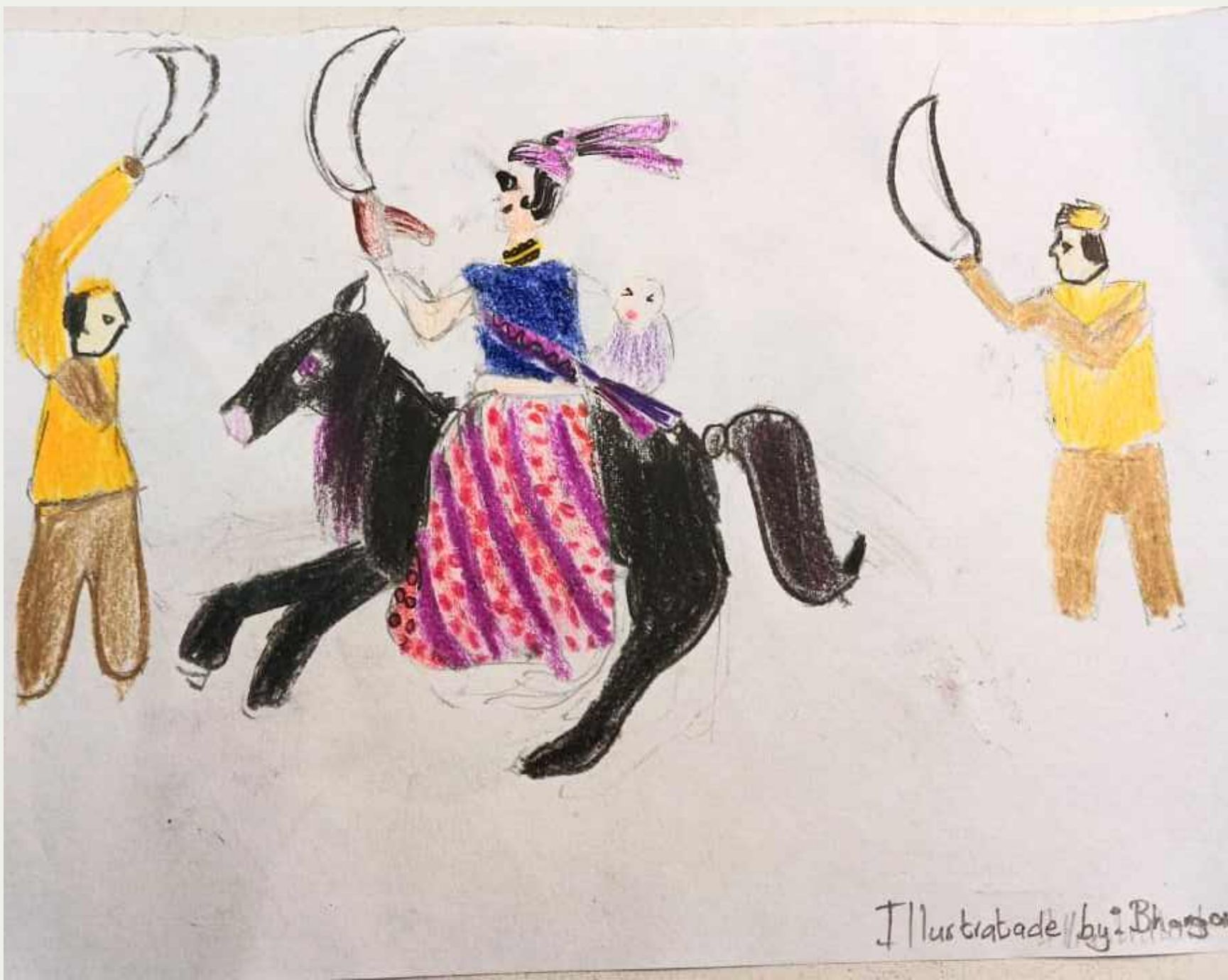
BLUE AND GREEN GROUPS

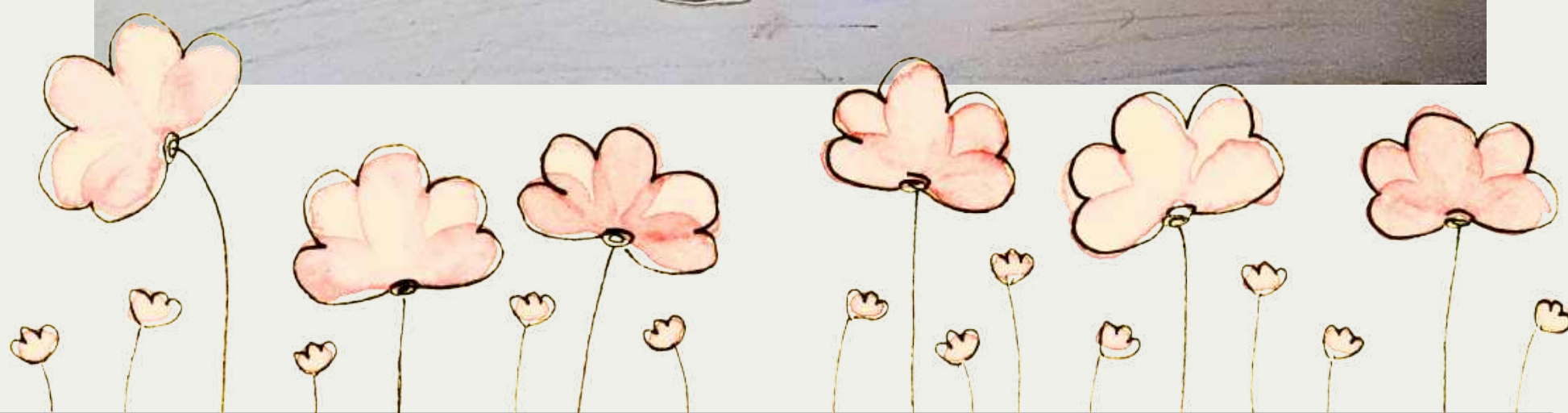
BHAGAT SINGH -A PLAY

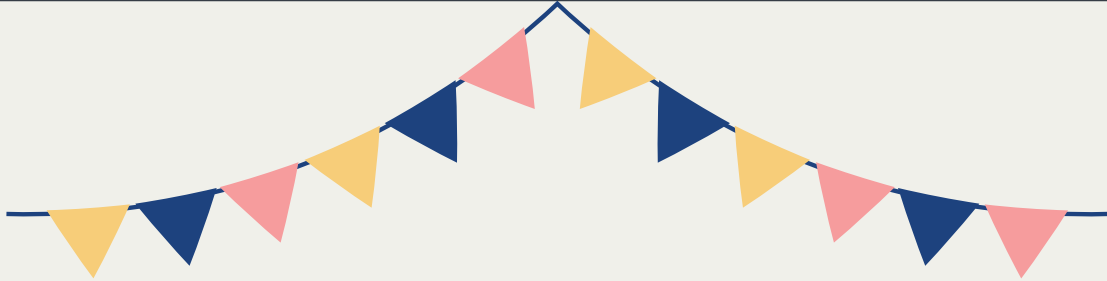
FREEDOM FIGHTERS - A PLAY BY TRINITY AND HUMILITY GROUPS

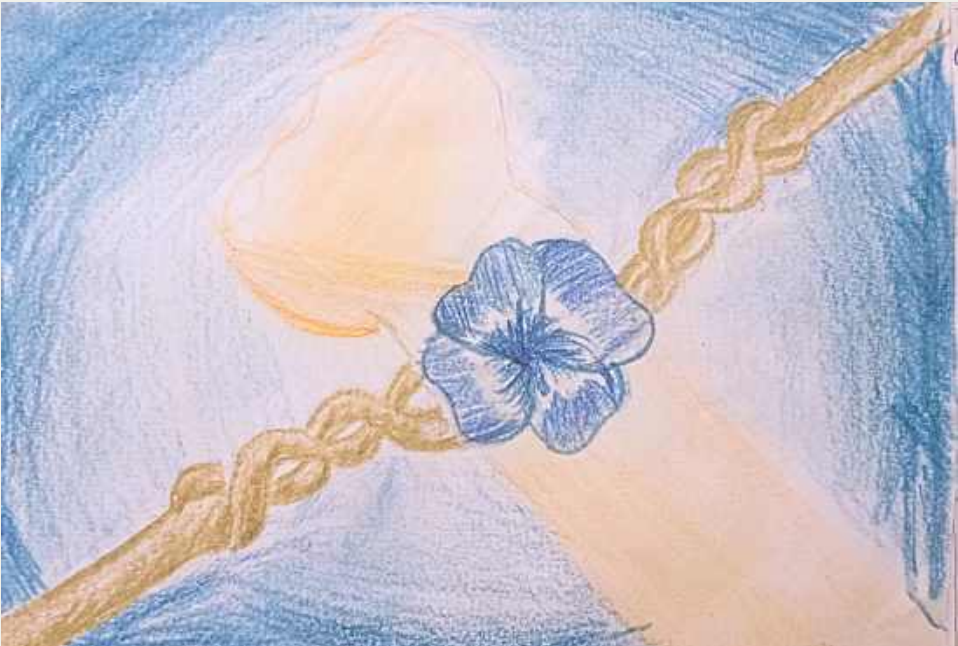

BLUE GROUP

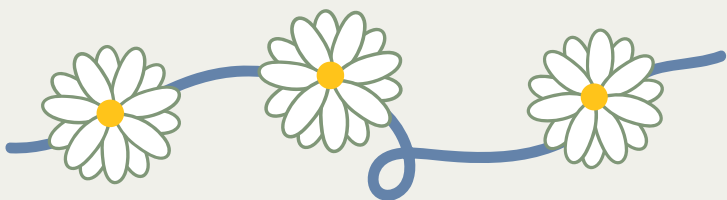

ORANGE AND GOODNESS GROUPS

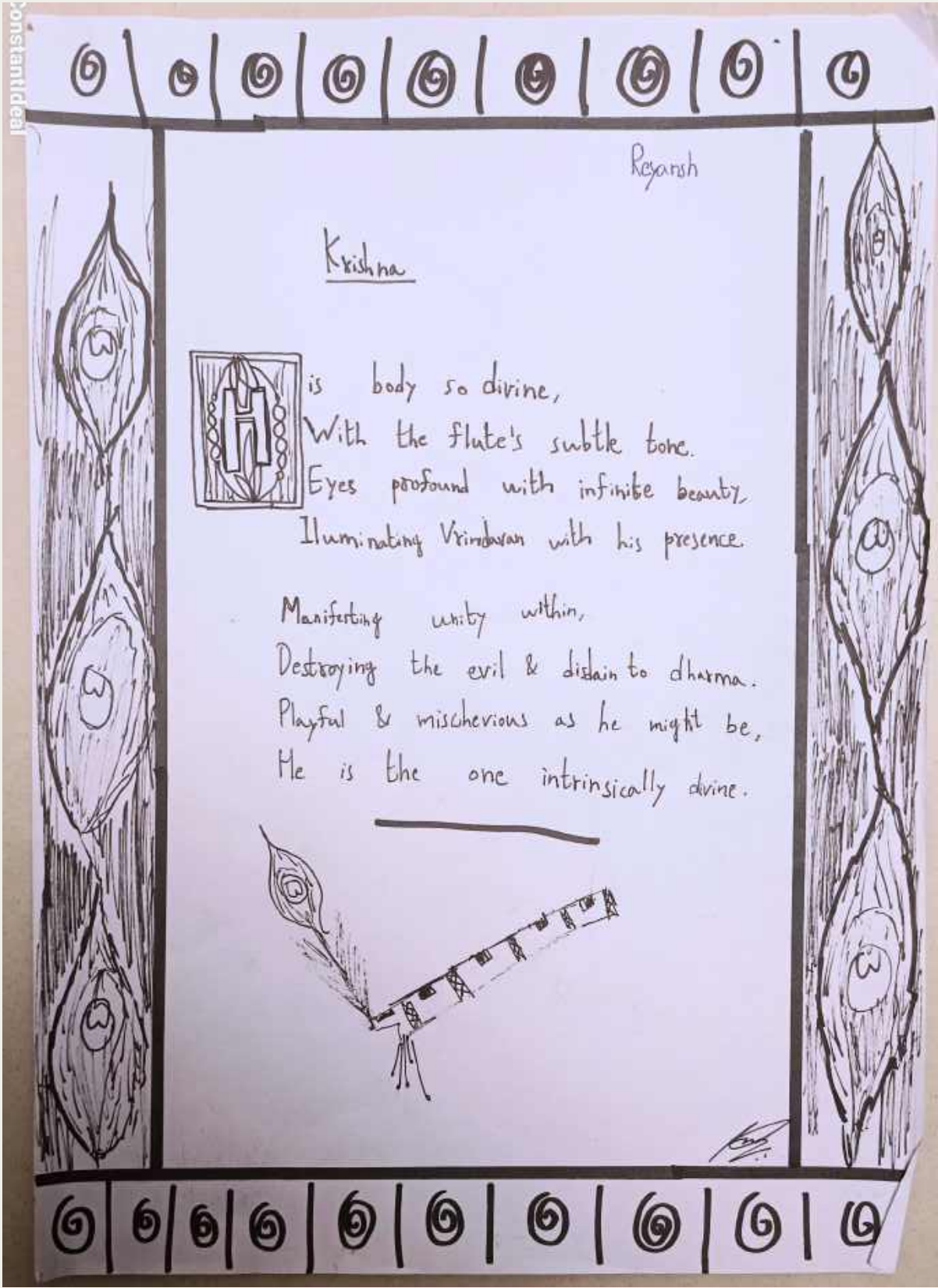

Many species are in extinction.

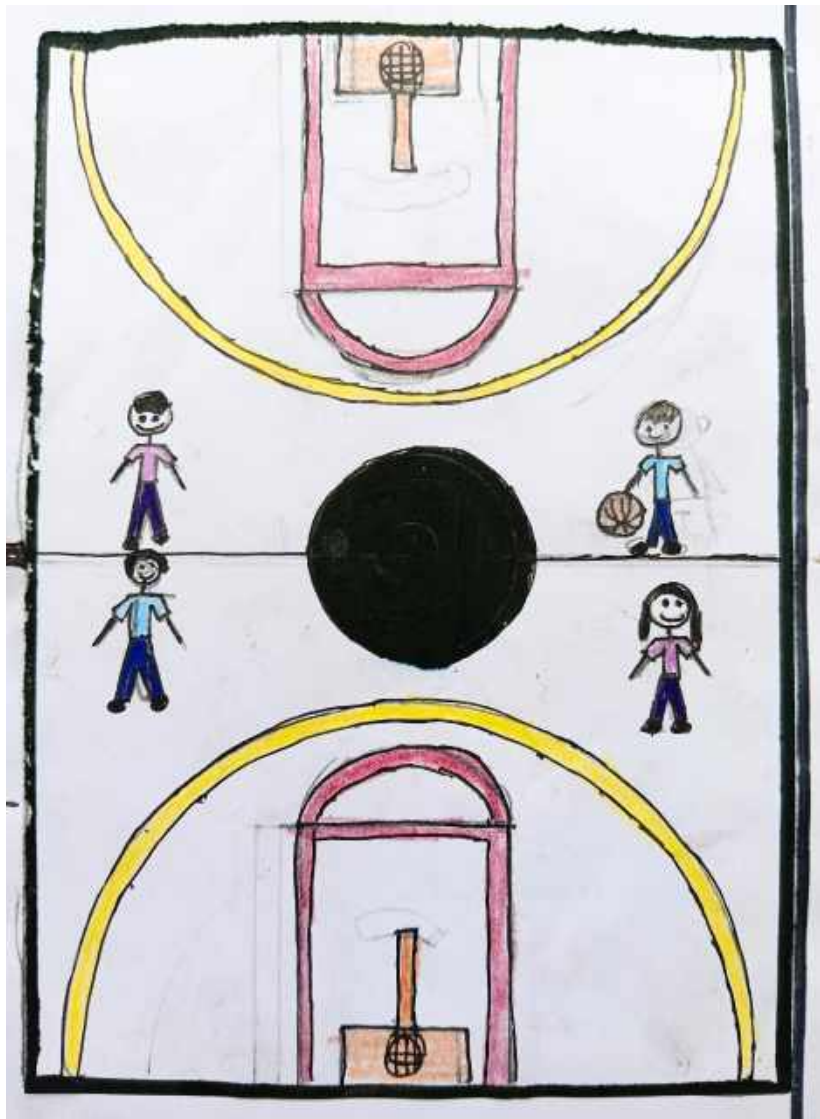
The climate is changing,
